CORNELL Composting

A composting toilet is a type of toilet that treats human excreta by a biological process called composting. This process leads to the decomposition of organic matter and turns human excreta into compost. It is carried out by microorganisms (mainly bacteria and fungi) under controlled aerobic conditions. Most composting toilets use no water for flushing and are therefore "dry toilets".

5 Aerated Static Pile General Description: Aerated static pile composting is comprised of forcing (positive) or pulling (negative) air through a trapezoidal compost pile. Agitation only occurs when piles are combined or moved to a different area for curing.

COMPOSTING PROCESSING TECHNOLOGIES

Compost (/ ˈ k ɔ ː m p ɔ ː s t / or / ˈ k ɔ ː m p oʊ s t /) is organic matter that has been decomposed in a process called composting. This process recycles various organic materials otherwise regarded as waste products and produces a soil conditioner (the compost).. Compost is rich in nutrients. It is used, for example, in gardens, landscaping, horticulture, urban agriculture and organic farming.
