Tax Terminology [The Tax Structure p. 1-5] A. Tax rates can be structured to yield a: 1. Proportional tax: The rate of tax remains constant over the tax base; 2. Progressive tax: Tax rates increase as the tax base grows larger; or, 3. Regressive tax: Tax rates decrease as the tax base grows larger.
